The existing play area was a depressing large open tarmac space with equipment that was outdated and in need of repair. Funding to support a biodiverse design had been secured via Friends of Aldersbrook Park and the play area needed to reflect this with a more natural playscape.


Opened in October 2015, Proludic transformed the space through the introduction of soft landscaping and planting throughout the playground. The aim was to create 'playrooms' which were defined by landscaped spaces which served to soften the area and create a much more inviting and natural place for children to play and for adults to sit and enjoy the space. The use of artificial grass was the perfect design solution in the creation of a soft landscaped space for the local community to use.





We aimed to transform a traditional 1960's play area into a fusion of exciting new play products and landscaped design. Proludic achieved this using the very latest play equipment, high quality surfacing and large measures of creativity. The result has been a stunning success.
