The health and fitness statistics for children in Hounslow is very poor against the national average so the challenge for this project was providing the right equipment that could tackle this problem.

The introduction of a play and fitness trail provides physical challenge and also allows organised activities and courses to take place. The children at the school were involved in the design and installation as both Proludic and the school felt this was an important educational journey for them. It is also created ownership for them over the site completion as they felt a part of all the hard work that had gone into making the playground a reality. Today the playground is still popular at the school and it continues to keep all the pupils happy at break times.
