Project Story

Bryning-with-Warton Parish Council and the local community were concerned with the lack of facilities for youngsters within the village, with only a swing to play on. Locals formed a group called 'Make Bridges Brilliant', aiming to regenerate the children's play area.

The Council was awarded Section 106 monies with many new homes being built in the village. The Parish Council then began working with Proludic forming a partnership for four years. Working together every step of the way, from initial ideas through to final design.

The Council wanted to create a community space that would cater for all ages within the community. We managed to fulfil this by selecting specific products, a huge space net as the centrepiece, our iconic IXO unit, Rodeoboard and Aeroskate for older children and teenagers. An inclusive Pod-Swing and Wok Roundabout for all ages and abilities. For younger children, we selected our Diabolo range next to the original Cradle swings.
