Project Story

BAM construction requested a design for a small play area as part of their overall development for the M25 Motorway services at Cobham. The purpose was to provide an area for children and their families to play whilst taking a break from travelling. BAM contacted Proludic for an innovative design to sit within the new modern service area and to meet the needs of the travelling client base.

Proludic used the footprint provided by BAM to create an innovative play space that provided a wide range of play activities for children. It was designed specifically to allow children to play in an active way, thereby encouraging them to undertake challenging physical play during a welcome respite from travelling. The play space means that families would be encouraged to stay for elongated periods of time, therefore increasing the time spent at the services and revenue generated on each visit.
