


Gurnell Grove Themed Play for Housing

Project Story

Proludic were asked to provide an exciting design as part of a tender process for London Borough of Ealing Landscape section who were working on behalf of their internal housing department to enhance the play facility situated within Gurnell Grove housing estate, Ealing. The site was overlooked on all sides by high rise housing so they required a play space that was imaginative and fun.

Proludic designed a play space that would naturally draw children down from their homes. We did this by the use of bright imaginative graphics set into the wetpour that supported the use of the new Tema themed play equipment range which could be seen from their windows. The Metropolis range draws inspiration from Jules Verne and HG Wells and we added large coloured air balloons to complement this and create a stimulating place to play. Opened in March 2014—the site has been a huge success.



Proludic were awarded the playground project at Gurnell Grove following the issue of a design and build tender competition. We are very pleased with the outcome and in particular were very impressed by the standard of installation and workmanship by their sub-contractors EJ Services.
