Lybster is a small coastal village in Caithness, north of Scotland. As the local play area needed a refurbishment, Lybster Community group worked to raise £60k to build an amazing playground for the children. The winning design included a gigantic 5.4 metre high Amazon themed

tower with two slides including the main one that is over 3 metres high and almost 7 metres long! An inclusive roundabout, swings and a climbing hut playhouse





We had spoken to four play companies to look for the best design solution from them. After a public meeting to review each presentation, Proludic were chosen. This is one of the most distinctive and challenging play areas in the area and children come from miles around.
